

CULTURAL AND CREATIVE BUSINESS INCUBATION PROGRAMME

Afrique Créative, Partnering Talents

Afrique Créative is an ambitious support programme aimed at accelerating the development of cultural and creative enterprises (CCI) that create jobs, generate growth, and bring about change.

The **second edition** of the programme is structured around three phases:

- 1. Pre-incubation phase (for 15 to 18 entrepreneurs for 3 months)
- 2. **Incubation** phase (for 8 entrepreneurs for 6 months)
- 3. Acceleration phase (for 8 entrepreneurs for 3 months)


The 2021 call for applications is open until 23 May 2021 and will allow 18 entrepreneurs* to enter the pre-incubation phase.

At stake – the pre-incubation phase (3 months):

- > Technical support, in terms of entrepreneurial capacity building, provided by a local incubator.
- > E-learning courses common to the whole cohort on various subjects (HR management, marketing, etc.).
- > The possibility of pitching one's acceleration project in front of a jury made up of cultural and institutional players and investors, who select the 8 best projects for the rest of the programme (technical assistance and financial support)
